Dear Teachers, Parents, & Students,

In each session of this Junior Piano Program there is a time listed, approximately mid-session, that is meant to give you guidance with check-in times for students who are in the latter part of the session.

For students in the class immediately following this time, it is *imperative* that you check in *at least* 15 minutes earlier than the listed time. Not only is this in keeping with the general rules of our festival syllabus, it ensures that students are in the theatre and checked in with the music secretary on time. **If the session is moving faster than our “best guess” guideline, then we may even start the next section early.** We may, of course, also run later than the estimated time.

There are many variables that can determine the actual time an entry is performed (*last minute cancellations, speed of an adjudicator and/or when adjudications are held within a session*). All we can do beforehand is make an educated guess and offer you these times as a guide to help you.

Thank you for taking this into consideration when choosing your arrival time for your session.
