Ildiko Skeldon-Huber received her Bachelor of Music Degree - Piano Performance – from the University of British Columbia. While her principal teachers were Lee Kum-Sing and Pawel Checinski, she also received coaching performing in master classes with Robert Silverman, Ivan Moravec, Menaham Pressler and Anton Kuerti. Summer studies were pursued at the Liszt Academy in Budapest, Hungary.

Ms. Skeldon-Huber has been a senior examiner with the College of Examiners – RCM Examinations Toronto - since 1994, examining in both Canada and the USA. She has adjudicated numerous festivals across Canada and is a member of the Canadian

Music Festival Adjudicators Association.

An active member of the B.C. Registered Music Teachers Association, she currently serves as the Chairman of the Board of Examiners for B.C. Provincial Council, after having been Branch President (Richmond) from 1991-1997. She is also the Chair of the Professional Development Committee for B.C. Provincial Council. She is also on the Board of Directors for the Richmond Concert Association.

Her own solo CD was released in 2002 – a recording of live solo piano performances encompassing the past 20 years of her performance career. The CD's "Dynamic Duettists" – Volumes 1 & 2 released in 2007 and 2008 - feature her studio's student ensembles.

Ms. Skeldon-Huber now devotes her energies towards pedagogy and directs a successful music studio in Richmond, B.C. Her student of 14 years, Kenneth Lee, was chosen to represent Richmond at the B.C. Piano Competition held in Harrison, B.C. in Sept. of 2008.
