The name of the Society is NORTH ISLAND FESTIVAL OF PERFORMING ARTS

The purposes of the Society are:

1. The name of North Island Festival of Music Association (changed to North Island Festival of Performing Arts October 20, 1995)
2. The Objects:
 - a. To advance, promote and develop Music Competition Festivals, and encourage study and practice of the art of music, either alone or in conjunction with related arts.
 - b. To offer and grant awards or prizes in money or otherwise for excellence or proficiency in any branch of the art of music, either alone or in conjunction with related arts, and to appoint examiners and adjudicators for the purpose of assisting in the assigning of such awards or prizes.
 - c. To stimulate a greater appreciation and understanding of good music.
 - d. To discover and encourage musical talents in young and old.
 - e. To make available to those who compete, the constructive criticism of musicians who are outstanding in their profession and who have the experience of competitive festivals elsewhere to bring to this area.
 - f. Through scholarships, to give some assistance to those who desire to progress in their knowledge of music and in their availability to perform and teach it.
3. The operation of the society will be carried on chiefly in the Comox Valley Area, in the Province of B.C.
4. The income, profits and property of the association whensoever and wheresoever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Association as set forth in this memorandum of association, and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise howsoever by way of profit to the members of the association. The payment of any dividend to the members of the association is hereby prohibited. In the event of the winding up of the association, all the property both real and personal shall be distributed in accordance to the constitution. This provision is unalterable in accordance with section 17 of the societies act.
