

## NIFPA Scholarship

The NIFPA Scholarship is open to students who have performed and participated in two (2) consecutive festivals including the year of application, whose entries made them eligible for consideration as a representative at the Provincial Festival.

### Eligibility:

1. Participants living and studying within the NIFPA boundaries of
  - School District 68 Nanaimo/Ladysmith
  - School District 69 Qualicum
  - School District 70 Alberni
  - School District 71 Comox Valley
  - School District 84 Vancouver Island West
  - School District 72 Campbell River
  - School District 85 Vancouver Island North
  - School District 47 Powell River
2. Participants who have performed in two (2) consecutive festivals including the year of application, whose entries made them eligible for consideration as a representative at the Provincial Festival.
3. In the year of application, applicants must be registering in a full-time or part-time post-secondary program at a recognized education institution. This includes a post-secondary training program at a recognized dance education institution.
4. Previous scholarship winners are not eligible.
